

What is CHRIST RENEWS HIS PARISH?

Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP—pronounced “Chirp”) is a process designed to bring members of a parish together in Christ. All of our commitments, including our commitment to Christ, need renewal if we are to be faithful. CRHP is an effective spiritual renewal process, which calls together the members of the parish—priests, religious and laity, in order to experience conversion and Christian community in the environment of our own parish.

Who May Participate?

Every member of the Parish is invited to attend. Men and women participate on different weekends. Suggested age is 21 and older.

What are the Dates and How Long Will it Last?

Each weekend will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and will end by 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Men’s weekend will be September 10-11, 2011.

Women’s weekend will be October 1-2, 2011.

What Happens During the Weekend?

Come prepared to have **FUN** and to renew your heart. It will include group activities and interactions, prayer together, and some reflection by “team” members on such subjects as: “The Father’s Loving Care, Scripture, Eucharist, Christian Community, and Christian Awareness.” Mass is celebrated on Saturday evening and on Sunday afternoon, with an opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Who Conducts the Weekend?

The weekend experience is presented by a “team” of participants from the previous Renewal Weekend.

Participants on the weekend will be asked to become part of the next team.

Where Do People Sleep?

Sleeping accommodations in the “Holy Family Hilton” are a bit unique. The motif is early American Classrooms, which will be arranged to provide sleeping accommodations. You need to bring a sleeping bag, air mattress, foam mattress, etc. Bring your own pillow and bedding, along with a towel and other toiletries that you might need. Remember, there is only one night’s sleep. We will have snorer’s and non-snorer’s accommodations.

What About Meals?

Meals will be provided by volunteers. You will not need to bring any food for yourself. There are regular breaks for cold drinks, coffee and snacks. If you have any special dietary needs, please let us know on a note with your registration form.

Can I afford the Cost of the Weekend?

Absolutely YES! The Renewal Weekend is a gift from the presenting team. No one in attendance will be solicited for funds. However, any private and/or anonymous donations will be *gratefully* accepted.

How Do I Sign Up?

You will be invited to become involved through announcements at Mass, in the bulletin, and perhaps by a personal invitation from someone you know at Holy Family Parish. It is up to you, as an individual, to make up your mind. Praying for guidance from God is important. If you feel that Christ, through the Holy Spirit or through a human mediator, is calling you.....COME! God calls us in many ways.

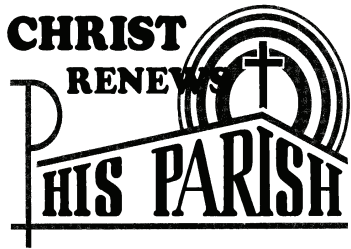
