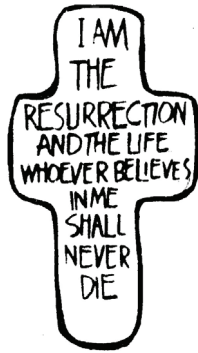

The Oil of the Infirm and the Oil of Catechumens are blessed and the Sacred Chrism is consecrated at this time. These Holy Oils impact the lives of those who are preparing to enter the Church, those who are ill, and all preparing for Confirmation and Holy Orders.
