**PRO-LIFE NEWS Abortion Funding in the New Health Care Reform Act**

- **Federal funds in the Act can be used for elective abortions.** For example, the Act authorizes *and appropriates* \$7 billion over five years (increased to \$9.5 billion by the Health Care and Reconciliation Act of 2010) for services at Community Health Centers. These funds are not covered by the Hyde amendment (as they are not appropriated through the Labor/HHS appropriations bill governed by that amendment), or by the Act's own abortion limitation in Sec. 1303 (as that provision relates only to tax credits or cost-sharing reductions for qualified health plans, and does not govern all funds in the bill.) So the funds can be used directly for elective abortions. Watch the bulletin for more pro-life information in the Sundays to come.

APRIL 20, 2010

Meeting was called to order by DeAnne at 7:04 p.m. Joan opened the meeting with a prayer. Minutes from the last meeting were reviewed and were approved as written.

The following old business was discussed: The organizational chart that had been drafted was presented and discussed. Many changes were noted. DeAnne will get a second draft of this for the council to review. Once this chart is finalized then the council will look at updating the Constitution and By-Laws.

The following commissions their terms are expiring: Family Life –Regina Clark/Deya Schanbacher; Missions – DeAnne Wickens; Religious Ed –Geri Graves. It was suggested that something be put in the bulletin about the openings for parishioners to consider. At the next meeting these commissions will present nominations for their replacements on the council.

The following commission reports were given:

**Family Life – Regina Clark** - Regina has begun to make plans for Vacation Bible School. The anticipated date for this event is August 2 thru August 6<sup>th</sup> to be held in the evenings. She is contacting individuals to serve as directors. She asked Colette about the high school Youth group

**Finance** - Finance report was given for March. The total deposits were \$115,866.98 while the total expenses were \$80,130.67. No major expenses noted.

**Property – Martin Meyer** - Martin noted some needs of the school that would need to be considered and planned for under long-range needs. The school board is looking at a new HVAC system and the gym roof is 20 years old and we will need to plan for this. New windows have been being replaced and recently five new windows were installed in the school.

**Religious Ed – Geri Graves**

Geri reported that several attended the “Why Catholic” Reflection meeting in Monroe. The “Why Catholic” program will start up again in September.

Geri plans to ask Roseanne Roy to consider taking her spot on Parish Council.

Geri plans to put some information in the bulletin in regard to the Health Care Reform Bill and Pro Life issues.

Geri reminded everyone of the upcoming Missouri Right to Life Yard Sale. You may drop off items for the sale on May 17<sup>th</sup> thru the 19<sup>th</sup>. The sale begins on Thursday evening, May 20<sup>th</sup> and continues on Friday, May 21<sup>st</sup> and till noon on Saturday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>. They could also use help tearing down after the sales closes on May 22<sup>nd</sup> at noon.

**School – Melissa Millan** - School Board elections will be held at the masses on May 1<sup>st</sup> and May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

End of school year is approaching and registration for the next school year is going on now. Anticipates enrollment to be around 186 students. Melissa reported that staff is in place for the next school year.

There has been \$1,000 donated toward Vacation Bible School.

**Worship – Joan Albright** - They are trying to locate the bells that were used in old Blessed Sacrament Church for use at the Consecration during Mass. She is planning on taking her proposal for items for live Stations of the Cross to the Knights of Columbus for consideration.

**Youth – Colette Markell** - Confirmation will take place on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. We have 24 students and one student from Monroe will be attending. Some other events planned are Prom Mass at 3:30 p.m. on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Youth holding fundraisers for their Steubenville trip. On Mother’s Day weekend they will be selling Carnations after Masses and car wash on May 16<sup>th</sup>. On May 22<sup>nd</sup> the Youth will be leading the Pentecost mass.

**Sr. Virginia** - Religious education classes will be having their closing mass on April 28<sup>th</sup>. RCIA has two more meetings and then a picnic planned for May 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Fr. Mike** - June parish council meeting was scheduled for June 22, 2010. This will be our annual picnic. New parish council members are invited to attend. Fr. Mike stated they are looking at allowing parishioners to use St. Michael’s Hall. There will be some type of rental fee and they are working up guidelines in regard to this. This information will be presented to parish council for review. May 18<sup>th</sup>

Dylan Schrader will be celebrating his first mass here at Holy Family on May 23, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. Afterwards we will host a meal for Dylan, family, friends, etc immediately following the mass in St. Michael’s Hall. If you plan to attend you are to call and make reservations at the parish office.
